"The firm is continuing to develop resources that explain how those matters move from initial review through investigation, negotiation, and, when applicable, litigation."

The firm's personal injury resources address questions concerning filing deadlines, comparative negligence, damages, insurance claims, wrongful death, workers' compensation, and premises liability. The library also

groups information according to practice areas, including motor vehicle accidents, construction accidents, medical malpractice, catastrophic injuries, and other civil matters.

Personal injury litigation generally examines whether a party owed a legal duty, whether that duty was breached, whether the breach caused an injury, and what damages resulted. The evidence reviewed in a particular matter can include medical records, accident reports, photographs, witness statements, insurance documents, employment records, expert findings, and other materials connected with the circumstances of the incident.

Motor vehicle matters represent one category addressed through the firm's materials. These cases can involve automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, commercial vehicles, pedestrians, or other road users, and the legal analysis can include questions involving negligence, insurance coverage, causation, medical treatment, and damages. Delaware law and the applicable insurance policies determine the procedures and requirements that apply to an individual matter.

The resource library also covers premises liability and workplace injury matters. Premises claims can involve questions concerning property conditions, maintenance, notice, and responsibility for an alleged hazard, while workplace injuries can involve separate workers' compensation procedures and administrative requirements. A single incident can sometimes raise issues under more than one legal or insurance framework, depending on the facts.

Medical malpractice claims involve additional procedural and evidentiary considerations. Records concerning diagnosis, treatment, professional standards, causation, and damages can become part of the review, and expert analysis can be relevant to questions involving professional conduct. Delaware statutes and court rules establish requirements that differ from those governing ordinary negligence matters.

Schuster Jachetti LLP also publishes information concerning the stages of an injury claim. An initial review can be followed by evidence preservation, investigation, communication with insurers or other parties, negotiation, and civil litigation when a dispute is not resolved through earlier procedures. Pleadings, discovery, motions, depositions, expert testimony, settlement proceedings, and trial can become part of a litigated matter.

The firm operates four Delaware offices in Wilmington, Smyrna, Georgetown, and Lewes. Its office information identifies the Wilmington location at 3407 Lancaster Pike as the primary office and places the firm's additional locations in Kent and Sussex counties. The multi-office structure gives the firm physical locations across all three Delaware counties.
